Description

The Community Path Project Committee will:

- Provide biannual progress reports to the Select Board and annual updates to Town Meeting, or as requested by the Select Board or Town Moderator;
- Review project schedule regularly and communicate with town and state officials as appropriate to help maintain the schedule;
- Share design and construction updates with the public at specified project milestones, through public meetings and/or written updates;
- Coordinate with other committees that are impacted by or may interface with the project;
- Collaborate and work with state and federal agencies for funding and construction schedule; and
- Prepare recommendations for the maintenance of the completed path.

Specific to Phase 2:

- Lead public engagement with the local community;
- Collaborate with local stakeholders to finalize the route and design of the path and its support structures;
- Support securing Transportation Improvement Plan funding, and other grant opportunities; and
- Steward progress of the design consultant toward completion of the project construction plans and specifications as scheduled.
